#### My dear Confreres,

I wish you all a blessings-filled Sunday! Today's Gospel (Mt: 25:1-13) presents the parable of the ten virgins who came out to meet the bridegroom, five of them were foolish, and five were wise. The foolish ones came without sufficient oil with their lamps, whereas the wise ones came prepared with sufficient oil. The bridegroom came late at midnight, and when they were called to



welcome the bridegroom, they did not have sufficient oil in their lamps and could not enter into the banquet hall with the groom. So today, we are all exhorted to remain vigilant and to carry extra oil (by way of purposeful planning, prayerful preparation, and positive persistence) in our lamps to meet the bridegroom, who is Christ the Lord, when he comes.



We had been waiting for our Provincial Congress, which is a Divine-Human historical event in the life of a Province family. It can be a *Kairos* for the life and mission of the new Province. We are happy that, after having assessed the present situation in the Province, in the context of the Covid-19 pandemic, and to propose the way ahead for us as a newly established Province, we could finally discern and decide to reconvene our postponed Provincial Congress 2020 for the first week of December 2020.

## RE-CONVOCATION OF THE 1<sup>ST</sup> ORDINARY PROVINCIAL CONGRESS OF DIBRUGARH PROVINCE 2020

In accordance with the Constitutions of the Congregation (Con. 234ff and GD. 261ff), with the prior approval of the Superior General, Rev. Fr. Abraham Vettuvelil, (SG-AB2 20-19) and with the consent of the Provincial Council, I am glad to re-convoke the postponed 1st Ordinary Provincial Congress of the MSFS Dibrugarh Province, with the theme "MSFS Dibrugarh Province: Rooted and Formed in Charism, Committed to Mission", from December 01st (at 08.30 a.m.) to 03rd (at 08.00 p.m.) 2020, to be held at Christashram (Diocesan Pastoral Centre), Dibrugarh, Assam, subject to the Covid-19 protocols. All the members of MSFS Dibrugarh Province with active voice are convoked to take part in the Congress (Cf. GD 277). If anyone is unable to take part in the Provincial Congress due to unavoidable circumstances, except those who are abroad and students, kindly take permission for absence from the Provincial at the earliest, latest by the 14th of November, 2020.

#### **Preparation for the Provincial Congress 2020**

The Steering Committee, which is already constituted for the preparation and organisation of the Provincial Congress 2020, consisting of Fr. Jose Karipadathu (Convenor), Fr. Philip Mhonchumo, Fr. Vintu Augustine Avittapallil, Fr. George Vadakkepericherimannil, Fr. Varghese Paul Manickathan, Fr. Carlus Barowa and Fr. Sunny Panthanazhivadakkethil, have already held their meeting on 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2020 and chalked out the immediate course of actions. Since the Pastoral Centre has agreed to accommodate us subject to the following of Covid-19 protocols, I suggest the following: 1) only those who feel healthy attend the Congress, 2) as far as possible, use private vehicles to travel to the place of Congress, 3) wherever possible, you may undergo at least a RAT (Rapid Antigen Test) and have a Covid-19 negative certificate before you come for the Congress, 4) thermal scanning be done every day morning and 5) to use facial masks and keep social distance being at the centre. Thank you, dear confreres, for your understanding and collaboration!



#### Celebration of the Foundation Day and 175 Years of MSFS Presence in India



**MSFS** Dibrugarh Province celebrated 182nd the Foundation Day of the Congregation and the 175th Anniversary of the arrival of the first MSFS in India on 24th October 2020 at SFS Campus Silapathar, with the confreres and sisters of all nearby MSFS Centres. The day was solemnized by Rev. Bp. Albert Hemrom the Coadjutor Bishop of Dibrugarh Diocese who presided over the Thanksgiving Eucharistic Celebration for the Evangelisation of Peoples. Fr Emmanuel Mappilaparambil, the Provincial of MSFS Dibrugarh Province welcomed the Bishop and everyone present for the Eucharistic Assembly introducing the importance of the occasion. The Bishop highlighted in his homily that the Consecrated Life when it is lived well automatically makes us evangelisers. After the Holy Eucharist a short felicitation programme was arranged in honour of Fr. Sudhir John Kullu, who celebrates his Sacerdotal Silver

Jubilee this year. He was felicitated with a shawl by the Bishop and a memento by the Provincial. The event was organised following the Covid-19 protocols and was attended by 26 priests, 1 deacon, 12 sisters, and 7 novices.
