My dear Confreres,

Mary.

I wish you all a blessings-filled Christmas and a grace-filled New Year 2021! We are celebrating Christmas at a time when the whole world continues to be held under the spell of the Covid-19 pandemic. Its social, economic and religious impact on the whole world and mankind, is beyond description. Even after ten months or more, we do not have any concrete solutions and antidote to arrest the spread of this pandemic. Now, there is even the threat of a new variant of the deadly virus with greater increase of transmission. It is in this context of crisis that we reflect on the true meaning of Christmas.



Christmas is a feast of joyful hope, for God has become one with us in the person of his Son, true God and true man. He showed his love for us by becoming part of our world, with all its conflicts, its suffering and its poverty. Jesus is truly Emmanuel: God with us. This is the great "gift" which He brings: a divine love which heals and transforms our hearts, overcoming all uncertainty and pessimism. Our joyful contemplation of the mystery of Christmas should make us realize that, as God has become one of us, we too are called to become like God: humble, close to others, especially to the poor, and ever attentive to their needs. In the *Urbi et Orbi* Blessing and prayer service on March 27, 2020 in a deserted St. Peter's Square, Pope Francis noted that the coronavirus "has exposed our vulnerability and uncovered those false and superfluous certainties" and "uncovered once more "our belonging to one another as brothers and sisters". This is also stressed in *Fratelli tutti*, his Encyclical devoted to the theme of fraternity and social friendship (see, FT 32). This Christmas, let us ask Mary, Mother of Jesus and our Mother, to help us see in our neighbour the face of Jesus, God made man. May we be in this world a ray of that light which shone forth from Bethlehem, bringing the joy and peace to the hearts of all men and women!

The First Ordinary Provincial Congress of Dibrugarh Province 2020

The First Ordinary Provincial Congress of the MSFS Dibrugarh Province, took place from 1st to 3rd December 2020 at *Christashram* (Diocesan Pastoral Centre), Dibrugarh, Assam, with the theme **"MSFS Dibrugarh Province: Rooted and Formed in Charism, Committed to Mission".** The orientations of the Provincial Congress reminded us that united as a family in Triune God and rooted in the Charism of our Founder, we are called to live as community of brothers and Missionaries of Christ. In all, 62 confreres (54 Members of the Province, 1 Delegate of the Superior General, 7 Special Invitees)

Covid-19 Relief: MSFS Pioneers' Survival Kit

MSFS Dibrugarh Province celebrated the Foundation Day of the Congregation and 175th Jubilee year of the arrival of the first MSFS Missionaries in India on 24th October 2020. Our heroic pioneers had ventured into our motherland and survived all the odds of the time trusting in God with their limited resources. Following the footsteps of our holy Founder Fr. Peter Mermier and the six pioneering missionaries, our missionary endeavors have been always an expression of our option for the poor and the disadvantaged.



To mark the 175th anniversary of the arrival of our pioneers in India, MSFS Dibrugarh Province conceived and implemented a project namely "COVID-19 RELIEF: MSFS PIONEERS' SURVIVAL KIT" in honour of our six pioneers. Pope Francis proclaims 'Year of St Joseph'

With the Apostolic Letter *Patris Corde* (With a Father's Heart), Pope Francis recalls the 150th anniversary of the declaration of Saint Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. To mark the occasion, the Holy Father has proclaimed a 'Year of Saint Joseph' from 8 December 2020, to 8 December 2021. Pope Francis describes Saint Joseph as a beloved father, a tender and loving father, an obedient father, an accepting father; a father who is creatively courageous, a working father, a father in the shadows. The Holy Father wrote *Patris corde* against the backdrop of the Covid-19 pandemic, which, he says, has helped us see more clearly the importance of 'ordinary' people who, though far from the limelight, exercise patience and offer hope every day. In this, they resemble Saint Joseph, "the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence", who nonetheless played "an incomparable role in the history of salvation."
