My dear Confreres,

We are very happy and excited that our Superior General, Very Rev. Fr. Abraham Vettuvelil MSFS has announced his Canonical Visitation to our new Province from 12 December, 2021 to 09 January 2022. I, on behalf of the entire MSFS Dibrugarh Province, welcome you dear Rev. Fr. Abraham warmly to our new Province and wish you a blessing-filled visitation! Let this spiritual event be an occasion for evaluation, renewal, and reinvigoration of the Province Life and Apostolate (Art. 201/vi).

Canonical Visitation of Superior General

Our Constitutions state: The Superior General through his visits enhances the quality of religious life, enlivens the apostolic zeal, and fosters love and teamwork among the confreres (Art. 201/v). Therefore, the focus of his Visitation, as he spells out, is:

- 1. Meeting all confreres personally and in Local Community
- 2. Evaluation of Community Life
- 3. Strengthening of Community Life and Apostolates
- 4. Renewal and reinvigoration of the Local Community and Province Community

Accordingly, he also proposes the following guidelines for the Visitation:

- 1. A minimum of half hour with every confrere
- 2. Meeting with the Local Community: The Superior of the Local Community prepares a Reflective Report with an evangelical critique on community life, religious life and Apostolate of the Community.
- 3. The report highlights the strength, weakness, opportunities, and possibilities in the Mission of the Local Community
- 4. Half hour Adoration with the Local Community
- 5. Identify one area that the Community will focus in the next 3 years
- 6. How far the Call of the General Chapter 2019/Provincial Congress 2020 is being realized in the Community?
- 7. Major challenges and concerns in the Local Community

As per the focus of the Visitation, Fr. Superior General wishes that it remains a simple and spiritual event in the Province. I would like to request all the Local Community Superiors to follow all the guidelines given by Fr. Superior General in preparing for his Visitation to our Communities.

Preparation for the Extraordinary General Chapter 2022

In preparation for the Extraordinary General Chapter 2022, Superior General has invited us to study seriously and reflect on four study papers prepared by the Expert Committee, appointed by the General Administration on the authorization by the General Chapter 2019, to educate, enlighten, and enrich us on the basics of our Congregation (MSFS, Wake up to the Basics). The Committee consisted of Fr. Jean Paul Fournier, Fr. Agnelo Fernandes, Fr. Jacob Parappally, and Fr. Sesetty Mariadas under the guidance of Fr Suresh Babu. We have already made efforts to study and reflect on the First Paper on the History of the Congregation in our apostolic community level. We shall take up the next three papers in the coming months for our study and reflection at personal, local community and apostolic community levels.

MSFS Value Education Books for classes 1 to 6

XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops

In March 2020, Pope Francis announced that the theme for the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops would be "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission". The journey towards the celebration of the Synod in October 2023 was solemnly opened on October 9-10, 2021 in Rome. On September 7, 2021, the preparatory document and the *vademecum* (handbook) for the synodal journey were released. With the convocation of the Synod of Bishops on the themes of communion, participation and mission, Pope Francis invites the entire Church to reflect on a theme that is decisive for

its life and mission: "It is precisely this path of synodality which God expects of the Church of the third millennium. This journey, which follows in the wake of the Church's 'renewal' proposed by the Second Vatican Council, is both a gift and a task: by journeying together and reflecting together on the journey that has been made, the Church will be able to learn through Her experience which processes can help Her to live communion, to achieve participation, to open Herself to mission. Our "journeying together" is, in fact, what most effectively enacts and manifests the nature of the Church as the pilgrim and missionary People of God".



The two-year long 'Synodal Journey' which the Church has begun and which will unfold itself in three phases of consultations -- at the diocesan, the continental and the universal levels -- culminating in the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops in October 2023, in Rome. Now all are invited to get actively involved in this synodal process at various, appropriate levels and we pray that it may really be an experience of journeying together of the entire People of God in the power of God's Spirit.
