- 1. **The Agony:** Ask for fervour in prayer. When the chalice of suffering falls to your lot, only continuous, agonizing prayer will win for you the grace to drink it.
- 2. **The Scourging:** mortification and purity. The sight of Christ lying at the foot of the Pillar, bathed in his own blood, will make sinful pleasure lose all its attraction.
- 3. **The Crowning with thorns:** meekness. Christ, mocked and derided, spoke not a word.
- 4. The Way of the Cross: Patience. Every follower of Christ must be a cross bearer.
- 5. **The Crucifixion:** Generosity. What have my hands done for Christ? My feet? My brain? My heart? What can I do for Christ? For those who suffer for justice?

3. THE GLORIOUS MYSTERIES

- 1. **The Resurrection:** We must live the new life in Christ. You are risen with Christ; live then the life of the risen Christ of charity, sincerity, peace and joy.
- 2. The Ascension: Go, teach all nations by word and example. Ask for zeal.
