


SUPERIOR GENERAL TO ALL THE MISSIONARIES OF ST. FRANCIS DE SALES


My dear Confreres!


1. THE SECRET OF FRANCIS DE SALES' SPIRITUALITY

 I often wonder how could SFS offer such remarkable spiritual insights at a very young age. What was his source? What was the secret of his spirituality? He brought a fresh understanding of living one's spirituality in daily life.





- I discovered that the insights that he garnered from his crisis in Paris and Padua, the physical illness he overcame, and the trauma of predestination that tormented him - turned out to be the foundation of Francis' spiritual journey.
- Our traumas and crisis can offer us spiritual insights that our intellectual minds cannot fathom. Francis underwent a profound crisis in reconciling his understanding with that of St. Thomas' and St. Augustine's teachings on predestination. Predestination became the core of his crisis. It led him to question himself about the eternal salvation that God had in store for him. He felt he was damned. The thought that he had no salvation paralyzed him.
- After going through many agonizing experiences, Francis finally resolved the issue and found peace in the radical and liberating truth of God's love. He found the secret hidden in the biblical texts that affirm God's wish to save all mankind. Loving God without asking for anything in return and trusting in divine love was the secret of Francis' life. He overcame the temptation by accepting unreservedly that God, revealed by Jesus, is a God of mercy and love. His appeal to everyone is to belong completely to God while being fully present in the world.
- Francis de Sales shows us that our depressing, agonizing, and humbling moments in life can offer us spiritual insights in a way that the intellectual mind cannot.



Prayer of St. Francis de Sales

"Lord, I am Yours, and I must belong to no one but My soul is Yours, and must live only by You. My will is Yours, and must love only for You. I must love You as my first cause, since I am from You. I must love You as my end and rest. since I am for You. I must love You more than my own being, since my being subsists by You. I must love You more than myself, since I am all Yours and all in You. Amen."

2. AN ILLUSTRATION

- I read a famous story about Russian Orthodox Archbishop Anthony Bloom. A young man came to him for spiritual guidance. He was angry and distressed because he could not make any sense of his Christianity. The dogma and theology seemed like garbage to him. The creeds made him furious. He yearned for a life of faith. After listening to the young man, Archbishop made а rather suggestion. That the young man should go home and make one hundred full prostrations a day for a month. In the orthodox practice, a 'full prostration' would mean to go flat on the floor, face down, with arms outstretched, and remain in that position for a long time. Only then one can rise to one's feet.
- When the young man returned a month later, his eyes were glowing with faith. The creeds no longer made him angry. The archbishop

- knew the reason full well. Through the deep, rhythmic gestures of bowing and emptying himself, the young man came to understand something that could not be found by the mind. In connecting with his body, frustration, and anger, he reconnected with the wellsprings of his faith.
 - Young Francis journeyed through deepest optimism. In depression into theological connecting with his bodily suffering and spiritual suffering, he reconnected with a loving God. The realization that the love of God does not reside in good feelings but resides in conformity with the will of God is the core of Salesian spirituality. We grow spiritually much more by going through physical, spiritual, and emotional suffering than by doing everything right. We grow spiritually much more by doing it wrong than by doing it right. Nothing in us wants to believe it. But that might just be the central message of how spiritual growth happens.



3. ST. FRANCIS DE SALES AND FATHER MERMIER

• Our models to follow Christ are our Patron and Founder. Both of them had the mission of Christ at the center of their hearts. We see their missionary enthusiasm in Chablais and the Parish Mission Preaching ministry. Both of them had to go through the pattern of suffering and renewal. They accepted the same pattern of Christ himself. Bible teaches us that the wrestling and wounding of Jacob were necessary for Jacob to become Israel. The death and resurrection of Jesus were necessary to give birth to Christianity. The suffering and crises of Francis and Mermier were necessary for the birth of the Congregation of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales.

The fruitfulness of the mission of SFS and Mermier is to be measured neither by their successes nor by failures according to our human standards and evaluations today. Their mission in the most troubled times in human history is to be measured by their conformity to do the will of God by confining themselves to the logic of the cross of Jesus.

May our Patron and Founder intercede for a renewal of every confrere in this Year of St. Francis de Sales!

SPA 2022

The fifth batch of SPA (Salesian Programme, Annecy) reached Europe at the end of August. After one week of personally guided retreat (Salesian Retreat), they moved on with classes and visits or site. On Sundays, they participate in the parish liturgies where MSFS are working under Franco-Swiss Province. The 8 participants are sent by their respective Provinces, and they are expected to animate and disseminate Salesian and Mermierian spirituality once back in the Province. At the end of the program, they will present one assignment each, and they will be granted a certificate.

Namely, they are Frs. John (South-East), Sanoj (South-West), Jerard (Pune), Japhet (East-Africa), Sandeep (Nagpur), Joby (Guwahati), Bijupaul (Dibrugarh) and Joseph (Visakh). Some of them were already designated for SPA in 2020, and again in 2021, but the Covid-19 crisis prevented them to join. Next week, they will also be part of the pilgrimage organized by FS Province for the Jubilee Year of SFS.
