We arrived at the formulation of the theme after an intense process of discernment, prayer, and sharing, keeping in mind the suggestions that emerged from the Extraordinary General Chapter, Provincials' Meeting with General Curia, and after listening to the reality of the congregation from the canonical visitation, animation, and the journey of our consecrated life in the present time. Having spent six years in an in-depth study of our charism and 'Waking up to our Basics', we renew our resolve to live our charism.

"General Chapter is the supreme legislative and teaching authority in the Congregation" (Art. 91). Our celebration of the General Chapter is a key moment to preserve the fidelity of the Congregation to its spiritual heritage (Cf. Can. 631/1) to collegially read the signs of the times and discern the working of the Holy Spirit. The objective is to awaken the original freshness of our charism and to generate fidelity to consecrated life and mission. We will focus on the prophetic dimension of our CHARISM, putting special emphasis on the community and mission dimensions of it.

Almost all religious congregations have a charism. The charism of a religious order is a particular gift or spirituality (gifted by the Founder/Foundress to the members) that they present to those they serve and to the Church. Each charism is unique and it serves as an identifying characteristic or identity of the congregation.

What is our MSFS Charism?

"Our charism is to continue the mission of Christ and His Church by living the spirit and spirituality of St. Francis de Sales in a religious community as missionaries, lived and envisioned by our Founder".

We are chosen. We are consecrated as religious. Our religious life should not be eclipsed by our priestly ordination, clericalism, and priestly ministry in parishes/institutions. Our MSFS vocation is essentially a call to be a religious (mystic) and a missionary (prophet) living in a community. We are called to be a synodal MSFS in today's world. It is said: *If you want to go fast go alone, if you want to go far go together.* We want to go far as missionaries. We want to go together as a community. We want to live our charism for the mission of the Church. We will be witnesses to Christ only when we live our charism. We can still go farther in our missionary journey as Father Mermier wants us to.

Test your desires through the exercise of discernment (SFS)


By experience, Francis had come to realize that desire is at the root of all true spiritual life, but also the cause of its debasement. Drawing abundantly from the spiritual tradition that had preceded him, he recognized the importance of constantly testing desire through the exercise of discernment. He found the ultimate criterion for this assessment in love. In that final conference in Lyon, on the feast of Saint Stephen, two days before his death, he had said: "It is love that grants perfection to our works. I will tell you much more. Take a person who suffers martyrdom for God with an ounce of love; that person merits much since he could give nothing greater than his own life. Yet another person who has only suffered a scratch with two ounces of love will have much more merit because it is charity and love that give value to our works".
